Line for sailing into the Harbour the rocky  
from B open between Point C & Point D.  
Sailing into the Typa keep the south shore on  
board till the Monally F opens over Rocky  
Point G in the line F, then steer for Shoal  
Point east  $\rightarrow$  in 4 fathoms water.  
The Harbour of Macao is drawn by the Eye  
and the Soundings taken at low water.
